March 18th: Abstracts due. Late submissions will be shown digitally, but not printed in the program.

Title and Abstract Submission

Please ensure your title, list of authors, and abstract are sent via google form link, <https://forms.gle/VzLowg8WAWDAXze17> , before the specified deadline. Abstracts received after this cutoff will not be included in the program if it has already been printed. It is crucial not to miss this deadline, and submitting early is highly recommended.

The body of your abstract should not exceed 1,800 characters (approximately 260 words) to fit within the page. Abstracts exceeding this limit will be edited for length. While we will attempt to return edited versions for your review, please note that due to the printing schedule, there may be limited time for revisions.

Your email should follow this format; replace the text within { } with your own details:
