March 18th: Abstracts due. Late submissions will be shown digitally, but not printed in the program.

Title and Abstract Submission

Your title, author list, and abstract should be submitted via google doc link, <u>https://forms.gle/VzLowg8WAWDAXze17</u>, prior to the deadline above. Abstracts submitted after this deadline will not be included in the program if the program has already gone to press. Please do not miss this deadline. Early submission is strongly encouraged.

Submit your title, list of authors, and abstract to Professor (UARK faculty advisor) via email before the specified deadline. Abstracts received after this deadline will not be included in the program if it has already been finalized. Ensure you do not overlook this deadline, and consider submitting your materials early for better chances of inclusion.

Limit the abstract body to approximately 1,800 characters (equivalent to around 260 words) to ensure it fits on the page. Abstracts exceeding this limit will be edited to fit.
