This award is presented to recognize outstanding high school mentors who have consistently motivated students to strive for higher achievement. Nominations for award recipients will be accepted by the Department through the American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) Student Chapter officers. Nominations will be made by students currently enrolled in Chemical Engineering at the University of Arkansas and will identify a team contact who will be responsible for contacting the nominee and securing their willingness to stand for the award.

Nomination packages will include an essay about how the nominee has influenced or motivated students to strive for success. Brief biographical information should be included when pertinent. Nominations are due by January 31 of each year. Awardees will be determined by the Department's AIChE officers by February 15. A maximum of three awardees will be chosen each year. Awards will be presented at the Annual Departmental Spring Banquet by the nominating team. Awardees will be ineligible for nomination for a period of four years (ex: a 2018 winner will be eligible for nomination again in 2021).
